Arrival is defined as the time the shipment arrives at the destination cargo facility and check-in notification via email is provided to the consignee.</p> <p>Free allowance calculation for Freight:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stations in the states of Alaska and Hawai’i, operated by Alaska and Hawaiian Air Cargo: Storage fees will be assessed after five days, excluding weekends and holidays. Stations outside of Alaska and Hawai’i operated by Alaska and Hawaiian Air Cargo: Storage fees will be assessed after 72 hours, excluding weekends and holidays. Stations operated by vendors: Storage fees determined by the vendor, starting at 24 hours.
